The **Government of Mozambique (GoM)** have applied for the Grant financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Power Efficiency and Reliability Improvement Project (PERIP)**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) will be provided over a 12-month period and include: (1): Assessment of the current situation of EDM in the application of GIAF-ERP for management of corporate resources: accounting, finance, human resources, procurement, logistics, information technology (IT), corporate planning and reporting. The assessment will cover (i) organizational structure of EDM with identification of units involved in management of corporate resources; (ii) detailed description of current processes and activities (P&A) carried out by EDM for management of all corporate resources; (iii) evaluation of actual use of ERP to support execution of each P&A; (2): Development of gap analysis with best practices for management of corporate resources in international experience relevant to EDM; (3): Identification and detailed description of proposals of improvements in the execution of P&A for management of all corporate resources aimed to optimize use of current functionalities of GIAF-ERP. Eventual incorporation of additional functionalities to GIAF; (4): Preparation of a detailed roadmap for implementation of the improved P&A for management of all corporate resources, including actions for incorporation and training of staff, eventual needs of new infrastructure (hardware, etc.) and other resources; (5): Provision of support in key stages of implementation of the improved P&A approved by EDM.

The **Electricidade de Moçambique, E.P** now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are corporate experience in: (i) Provide support to review and optimize execution of processes and activities (P&A) for management of corporate resources of the company through the GIAF-ERP making systematic use of the functionalities of the information system; (ii) design and implementation of similar projects, in particular in electric utilities, wherein at least two of them are in non-OECD member countries.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s [*Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants \[under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants\] by World Bank Borrowers*](#), January 2011 edition, revised July 2014, (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultants Qualification Selection (CQS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
