1. The Republic of Mozambique has received financing from the World Bank (WB) toward the cost of the Termane Reginal Transmission Project (TREP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the Contract for:

Plant, Design, Supply & Installation of 400 kV Single Circuit Transmission Line for Temane Transmission Project (TTP), Lot 6.

*The Contract will be jointly financed by the Development Bank of Southern Africa (DBSA). The procurement process will be governed by the World Bank's Procurement Regulations.*

For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.

2. Sociedade Nacional de Transporte de Energia (SNTE) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for:

Design, Supply & Construction of approximately 176 km, 400 kV Single Circuit (SC) Transmission Line from Chibuto Substation to Matalane Substation and approximately 43 km, 400 kV Single Circuit (SC) Transmission Line from Matalane Substation to Maputo Substation with bundled 4 x Tern conductor, one OPGW and a second shield wire ACS on self-supporting Y-shape tension towers and guyed V or self-supporting suspension steel lattice towers. The contract is required to be complete within a period of 30 months (**Lot 6**).

3. Bidding will be conducted through International Competitive Procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" (July 2016), Revised November 2017 and August 2018), ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
