**POST CYCLONE IDAI AND KENNETH EMERGENCY RECOVERY AND
RESILIENCE PROGRAMME FOR MOZAMBIQUE – (PCIREP)**

1. The Republic of Mozambique has received financing from the African Development Bank towards the cost of the Multinational-Programme Post Cyclone IDAI and KENNETH Emergency Recovery and Resilience Programme for Mozambique, Malawi and Zimbabwe– (PCIREP). The Programme aims to restore and improve sustainable livelihoods of the affected vulnerable groups of the population through (i) rebuilding the agriculture sector, (ii) rehabilitation of the infrastructure in particular roads and electricity and, (iii) Institutional Strengthening for climate resilience.
2. The rehabilitation of electricity infrastructure under the project will address three areas, namely:
 - (i) Construction of a new 30km 110kV line from Dondo to Beira (Munhava substation) to ensure that if the current line fails Beira is not plunged into darkness;
 - (ii) Reconstruction and upgrade the 70km, 66kV line to 110kV between Lamego and Guara-Guara (while this will increase supply capacity, reliability and robustness of the line, the fallen poles which rendered the line completely out of the system, will be replaced by lattice steel towers as a way of climate proofing the line); and
 - (iii) Repair of the Munhava substation, which was badly damaged while it hosts the largest feeders into Beira. In all components, a strong element of Building Back Better is required to bring climate resilience principles into the design of the new electricity infrastructure and the reconstruction of the damaged ones.
3. The services included under this assignment are to (i) Prepare Detailed Project Design of Transmission Lines and Substations; (ii) Prepare Bidding Document Packages and Provide Support in the Whole Tendering Process up to Contract Signing and Defects Liability Period; (iii) Supervise the Construction Works of the contracts which will result from these activities; (iv) Provide Technical Support in Contract Management

of all Contracts which will result from these activities; and (v) Capacity Building of EDM Staff part of the PIU (On job/Learning By Doing Process).The consultancy services shall ensure that EDM obtain economic and climate resilient solutions of high technical standards and that the project is implemented in compliance with the AfDB environment and social safeguard policies.

4. The Electricidade de Moçambique EP, the Implementing Agency for the rehabilitation of the electricity substations and transmission lines now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may constitute joint-ventures to enhance their chances of qualification
